Directive No. 79
Safety guidelines for communication teams in KKL-JNF land

In light of the request to reach areas managed by KKL- JNF, for filming days / Interviews, etc., below is a list of possible risks and recommendations for preventive action. Before entering into open areas managed by the JNF, please make sure that all staff members know / aware of the potential risks in these areas.

More information about the risks that are unique (if any) in the cell which the requested activity is being carried out, will be forwarded to you through a JNF representative in the area.

The information below is **not addresses** aspects / Potential risks relating to the work processes of the teams in the shade or any other professional process of your team.

Risk / hazard	Risk Management
Solar radiation	Use a skin protection cream / full dress / wide-brimmed hat
High temperature	Drinking heavily (non-carbonated) in small quantities
Extreme weather	Keep up-to-date with forecasts and if extreme weather is expected, avoid getting to the ground.
Flaming vegetation	Fire should be avoided, smoking must be strictly extinguished sources of fire.
Pits, trenches, terraces	Avoid stepping backward, standing in the language of pits / terraces, standing on firm ground. A first-aid kit attached to the activity.
Duds / explosives	Avoid stepping back, being alert and keeping your distance
Fuel tanks at work sites	Keep away, do not smoke near containers.
Space travel	Slow driving, keeping distance, and sitting in car seats only.
General body injuries	First aid kit / evacuation vehicle.
Garbage	Do not throw or leave trash on the visit site

- Ensure to have communication and telephone numbers of first aid personnel are That are close to the site of the activity.
- Notify your host / follows for any risk / hazard discovered during the visit.
